Education and community empowerment: Swiss Father Ernst Waser's social work in Flores

On 27 October 2016, Ambassador Yvonne Baumann visited several social projects in Werang and Wangkung in the island of Flores. In a tidy high school, Santu Klaus Kuwu, located in a remote area, all of 500 students learn German from the beginning of their education. What is more, a course center and boarding houses cater for underprivileged children and youths. The institutions are part of the comprehensive life-long work of Swiss Father Ernst Waser working towards upgrading community livelihood through provision of school facilities, scholarships for deprived students and community enhancing courses. Project related workshops, encompassing a carpentry, a water supply center and an animal breeding facility, have generated more than 100 jobs for young men and women in rural areas.
